Little Big Horn College and its 6 Peer Colleges

LBHC selected three regional tribal colleges – Blackfeet Community College, Fort Peck Community College, and Stone Child College (all located in Montana) – and three national tribal colleges—Bay Mills Community College (Michigan), College of the Muscogee Nation (Oklahoma), and Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe College (Wisconsin) – for peer comparisons. See the American Indian Higher Education Consortium map for the location of these colleges.

These peer colleges are, most importantly, comparable to LBHC in their mission – they are all tribal colleges with a mission to preserve, protect, and perpetuate their tribal language, history, and culture. These peer colleges are also similar to LBHC in size, student demographics, budget, and professional-technical/transfer mix.

IPEDS was the only available source of data for comparing retention and graduation rates with LBHC's peer colleges. Data were downloaded from <u>IPEDs</u> on November 26, 2023.




Fall-to-fall retention rates for first time full-time students (%)
